CPC's Citrix CSP Program allows clients to consume Citrix CVAD and NetScaler licensing as a service. Simplicity is at the core of the program. There is a single SKU for CVAD and a single SKU for VPX HA Pairs, both include Premium Support. The CVAD component is based on named users where one credit equals one user license per month. NetScaler is licensed as one VPX HA Pair per month.

The program offers a flexible consumption model with monthly, annual, and multi-year options.

Additionally, tiered pricing is available based on the number of users being licensed.
